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Cleopatra Megaways: Slot Overview

When you start roaming around the Ancient Egypt online slot section, it quickly becomes apparent that there is a lot, like, a lot of Cleopatra games. We're not just talking about slots that feature a female ruler in them, but actual games with the word 'Cleopatra' in the title. One of the most infamous of these is simply titled Cleopatra and comes from software provider IGT (now owners of Tj T* BT /F1 12 Tf 50 548 Td (iSoftBet). It spawned Cleopatra Megaways, a Megaways-spinoff from iSoftBet. Naturally, having Big Time Gaming's engine onboard means a certain level of modernisation, but Cleopatra Megaways manages to squeeze in one or two relatively classic elements as well.

Visually, Cleopatra Megaways is an upgrade over its older siblings, but not drastically so. It's got those classic-looking columns holding up each end of the gaming grid, the recognisably fonted game title up top, and loads of Egyptian-inspired icons littered about the place. Fans of the older games should feel pretty familiar with the surroundings, while those newer to the scene get the chance to fire up a slot with historical pedigree and a fairly modern, upgraded look.

To get the ball rolling, gamblers get to pick a suitable stake from options ranging from 20 p/c to R\$,Ç`20 per spin. Beneath the cultural shimmer lies a highly volatile math model doling out 96% theoretical return to player. Structurally, the game has a standard Megaways set up, which means 6 reels holding 2 to 7 symbols each - the precise amount can vary on each spin. Depending on how many symbols land on the reels determines the number of ways to win. At most, there can be 117,649 active ways.

Winning symbols are removed from the reels when they hit by the cascading wins mechanic. Symbols tumble down to replace them, and if a new w
